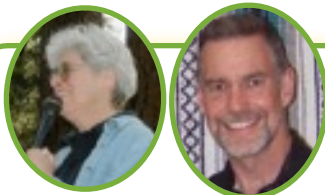
Greetings,

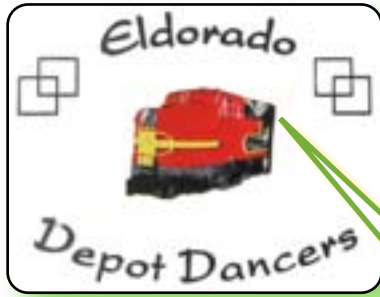

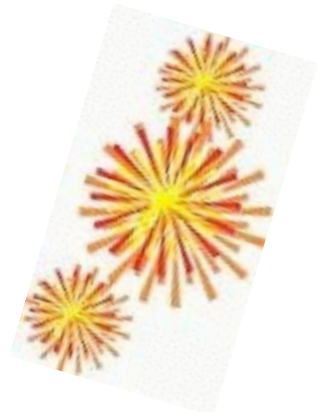

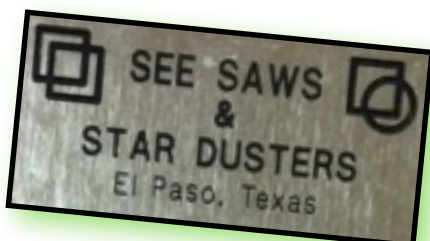
