

Callers and Potential Aspiring Callers

Mike Sikorsky is hosting a Caller's School at the ASDC June 17-20, 2016. There would be an afternoon and evening session on the 17th, morning, afternoon and evening sessions on the 18th and 19th and a morning and afternoon session on the 20th. All sessions are 3 hours long.

The cost for the school is \$189 per caller. If the caller brings one dancer to be in the demo squares, there is a \$30 discount. Each caller can get up to two additional \$20 discounts by bringing a 2nd or 3rd dancer for the demo squares. Demo squares would be used in 8 of the 10 sessions but only for half of the time. If a caller brought three dancers the price of the school would only be \$119.


NMSRDA membership Central District is from State Festival to State Festival, typically this is from June until May.



#### Hello Carole.

Thank you for your letter seeking permission to hold a square dance on top of Elephant Butte Dam. This is by far the most interesting request for access to one of our dams that I've ever received in my ten years with Reclamation. We are certainly supportive of such an interesting event at the dam as part of the centennial year, but I do have a few questions I'd like to address so we can proceed with the process to issue a special use permit.

It seemed to me that you are seeking to perform the square dance during the Southwest District Dance on April 30, 2016. Is that correct?

I see that you have insurance, which is essential, and will need about 30 minutes access to the top of the dam. If I understood correctly, you are seeking access for about 50 people and you are willing to carpool from another location to limit the number of cars at the dam site. This would be essential. We also require that anyone who is using the top of the dam (for example an Iron Man run crosses over the dam every year) provide their own law enforcement. It would likely suffice to coordinate with the local sheriff's department to see if a deputy could accompany you all for the period you are on the dam. It is also likely Reclamation staff would be in the area. I would personally love to get some photos for our use.

Due to our safety and security requirements we would need the name of every individual who will be participating. I will check with our law enforcement to see if they need any other identifying information.

I think that about covers things for now. I look forward to hearing back from you and working to get this approved.
