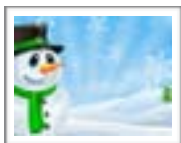
Be sure to get your nominations in the for the Hall of Fame. We need them in ASAP. Send them in.

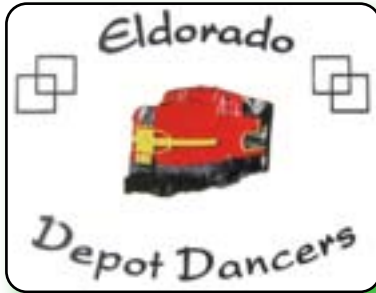

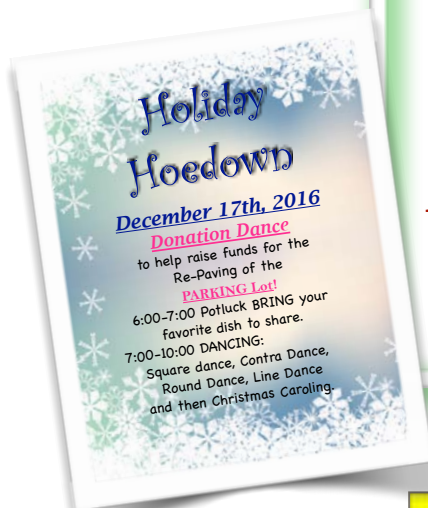

NMSRDA (New Mexico Square & Round Dance Association) State membership is from State Festival to State Festival, typically this is from June until May.

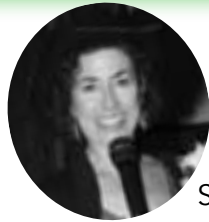
The NMSRDA card changes color every year.

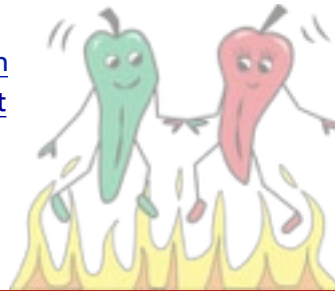

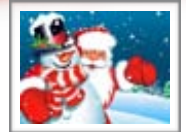

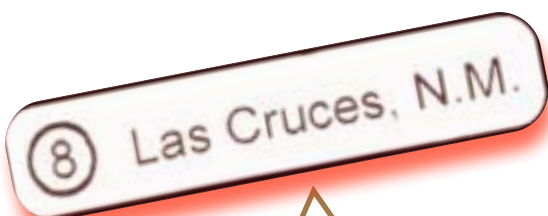
Hi All.
