Secretary's Report:

Treasurer's Report:

- Lynn reported a balance of \$3567.12, with income of \$4499.00 and expenses of \$931.88.
- There are 55 people registered for the State Festival of which 11 are singles and 22 are couples.
- NMSRDA has 115 paid members.
- Jerry motioned to approve the treasurer's report, and Mary seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

- Karen sent a letter to the mayor's office to request that May 17th be proclaimed State Square and Round Dance Day. She received a letter rejecting the request. Robert will submit a new request emphasizing that we are a non-profit, etc.

- Lisa submitted notices to Albuquerque the Magazine for their Date Book section to advertise the free Saturday morning classes.

2nd Vice President for Squares:

 Jerry sent an email to callers to inform them that they must be paid members in good standing with NMSRDA in order to call. They must also pay for registration this year. He has gotten a response from Robert Doyle.
