Hotel

Jerry is using La Quinta for Summer Song. He negotiated \$69/night for 20 rooms with 3 comp rooms. He worked with corporate rather than local representatives. We've had trouble with local management turnover at La Quinta and Days Inn so hopefully going through corporate would alleviate this issue. No decision was made as to a host hotel for our festival.

Prices

We compared several comparable festivals and decided on \$55/person early-bird, \$65/person after March 1st and \$10 off for NMSRDA members. No decision was made on prices for individual events.

Outfits

We decided to have prairie skirts for the ladies on the board with matching shirts for the men. We haven't settled on colors but black and silver were considered. The ladies will be on the lookout for fabric that would fit the theme at local fabric stores.

Feedback from a recent State Festival was that there was more round dancing than square dancing. We'd like to create a schedule that considers the ratio of square dancers to round dancers. We'll work on the schedule in a future meeting.
